INTERACTIVE MAP

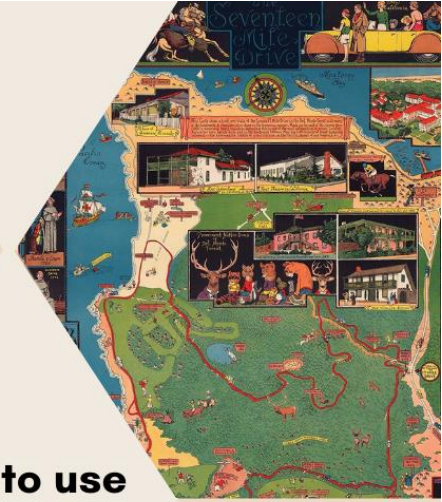
